Leigh Ann has worked with people with developmental disabilities, people with psychiatric disabilities, and seniors for over 30 years. She has worked in direct care, case management, and executive leadership in 14 states, the United Kingdom, and Canada. She has helped more than 200 people move from institutional settings to the community. Her expertise involves using person centered practices within long-term care.

Registration Fee Scholarships for People with Disabilities

There are a limited number of registration fee scholarships for people with disabilities. If you have limited financial means, are unemployed, or have to take unpaid leave from work to attend the conference, you may request a scholarship on your registration form. You must register by **May 7th** to be eligible.

Reimbursements for Family Members

There are a limited number of \$40 per day reimbursements for family members of individuals with disabilities. The registration fee must be paid in advance and the reimbursement will be mailed to you after the conference. Recipients must sign in both days and provide their contact information. You must register by **May 7th** to be eligible.
