ABLE Act Becomes Law in Oklahoma, Accounts Now Available Nationwide



Governor Fallin has signed the ABLE (Achieving a Better Life Experience) Act into law in Oklahoma. ABLE accounts are taxadvantage savings accounts for individuals with disabilities and their families. Ohio has become the first state to allow people nationwide to open ABLE accounts.
