### IEPA Executive Council

- Last met 1/30/19. Next meeting 4/24/19.
- [Collaborating Across Boarders VII Conference](#): Nine total abstract proposals were submitted
- [NEXUS Summit](#): Eight total abstract proposals were submitted

### Curriculum Committee

- Last met 3/11/19. Next meeting 4/8/19.

### Faculty Development Committee

- Last met 4/4/19. Next meeting 4/18/19.
- Group considered standardizing the ID/IPE Week. Will look at the first or third week of April.
- Group is considering [Train the Trainer training](#).
- Grants: Nine total applications were received for the 2019-2020 Wisdom Family Foundation Interprofessional Education Research Seed Grants. Grant Reviewers are scoring applications through April. Results should be returned to applicants no later than May 15, 2019.
- Training Curriculum: Group is using Kern's Curriculum Development method for creating a sustainable, long-term faculty development/training offering. Current considerations include: strategic needs analysis, 2019-2020 IEPA Provider Wellness series, facilitator training (with focus on the IPE Clinical Experience), and a facilitator simulation experience. Area experts will be needed to assist with future projects.

### Research Committee

- Last met 4/1/19. Next meeting 4/15/19.
- 2018-2019 Research Project: Final reminders will go to students next week.
- Guidance Document: Group reviewed language and revised the document again. Updates will be forwarded to the IEPA Executive Council for review.
- Research Strategy: Moving forward, the committee will begin drafting their research strategy plans. Using a template provided by IPEC, we will consider areas to move forward with upcoming interprofessional assessment and research projects. Area experts will be needed to assist with future projects.
