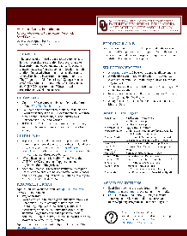

*The Interprofessional Educators & Practitioners Association (IEPA) welcomes faculty from all programs to participate in the planning and delivery of campus-wide interdisciplinary programming through service on our committees.*

### IEPA Executive Council

- Last met 11/28/18. Next meeting 1/30/19.
- Members of the Executive Council participated in a short discussion with the Graduate Council on 1/17/19. We are excited for opportunities to intentionally engage additional faculty members, staff, and students from across campus!

### Curriculum Committee

- Last met 1/14/19. Next meeting 1/28/19.
- “Developing and Sustaining an Interprofessional Team for Pro Bono Clinic Service Delivery” an abstract proposal, was submitted by members of the Curriculum Committee and accepted for Oral Presentation at the Eastern and Western Pro Bono Network Conferences. Congratulations to the writing team!
- IPE Clinical Faculty Mid-Term Debrief was held on 1/9/19. Valuable suggestions were gathered for implementation in Spring 2019 and in future clinical activities. Notes were returned to participating faculty, the Curriculum Committee, and to our community partner, Good Shepherd Clinic. Another debrief will be held following conclusion of clinic in March 2019.
