- The curriculum strategic revision teams provided updates and discussion regarding the finalization of the 2018-2019 curriculum framework. In particular, opportunities were explored for increased student participation in the development process.
- A draft curriculum was reviewed. The strategic review teams will finalize work for presentation at the executive retreat in June.
