- The Journal of Interprofessional Education & Practice has been recommended for possible publication of 2017-2018 study findings. Additional content is being gathered regarding submission requirements. Next steps will include a project team to prepare the manuscript.
- Additional qualitative data points may be considered for the article: programmatic student evaluations and EPIC clinic team debriefs.
- Project team will prepare the IRB proposal for 2018-2019 programming. IPAS is the overall recommended survey instrument since the results are more discerning than the CHIRP instrument. REDCap software is recommended for survey management and to facilitate data analysis. Additional development is needed to update the research questions and prepare for longitudinal analysis.
