Webinar Report: Promoting Health & Wellness Through Collaboration

- Webinar Notes:
 1. Dr. Lisa Desai presented analysis of the [National College Health Assessment II](#) findings on student mental health:
 - 54-65% rates of hopelessness (sad/anxiety)
 - 54.7-59.7% reported more than average stress
 2. Dr. Aviad Haramati discussed the physiological response to stress and referenced strategies from the [Mind Body Medicine Program](#) at Georgetown University. Program features:
 - Facilitator training for faculty members
 - 11-week course for students providing a support group, team communication, and exploring mindfulness techniques such as meditation and exercise
