Michael Stout, PhD from the College of Allied Health Received an R01, \$1.8 million from the National Institutes of Health to study the cellular senescence and epigenomic remodeling in ovarian aging

Diana Sturdevant, Ph.D., R.N. and Teri Round, M.S., R.N from the Fran and Earl Ziegler College of Nursing received a grant of nearly \$1 million from the Civil Money Penalties program, administered by the Oklahoma State Department of Health. They will provide training for administrators and directors and assistant directors of nursing; RNs and LPNs; and certified nursing assistants in the implementation of the 4Ms – What Matters, Medications, Mentation and Mobility – evidence-based elements shown to improve health and well-being by placing nursing home residents at the center of their care.

Jed Friedman, Ph.D, Karen Jonscher, Ph.D., and Kenneth Jones, Ph.D. received a \$2.3 million grant from the National Institutes of Health to investigate the role of the microbiome – the millions of bacteria in a person’s gut – and how the microbes passed from mother to child contribute to the onset of non-alcoholic fatty liver disease (NAFLD).
